**Memorandum of Understanding between
University of East Anglia (UEA), United Kingdom
and
University of Calcutta (CU), India**

This Memorandum of Understanding is made between:

University of East Anglia (hereinafter referred as UEA)

and

University of Calcutta (hereinafter referred as (CU))

UEA and CU are exchanging this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to develop a spirit of Academic Cooperation between each other.

Therefore,

1. The MoU aims to promote international academic cooperation and the exchange of teaching and research experiences between UEA and CU.

2. The two Universities will cooperate in developing friendship and mutual interests on a reciprocal basis of respect for the independence and equal status of each University.
3. The two Universities will agree to:
 - (a) exchange academic materials and information;
 - (b) mutually receive educational visit by faculty members, researchers, students and administrators;
 - (c) hold joint international conferences;
 - (d) promote faculty exchange and conduct joint research projects;
 - (e) engage in such other activities with mutual consent for enhancing mutual understanding and cooperation;
 - (f) student and academic staff exchanges.
4. This MoU is effective from the date of signature by the duly authorized representatives of the two Universities. The MoU may be revised/modified with the consent of both Universities.
5. The two Universities on mutual consent may co-opt any research partner from another University/ Institution.
6. Any dispute or differences that may arise out of terms and conditions of this MoU shall be settled through discussion and negotiations by the good offices of the Heads of the two universities. Any unresolved disputes will be referred to arbitration.
7. Both Universities agree that each shall bear their own costs for any work under this MoU (including travel, accommodation and subsistence costs of their own staff involved in visits associated with this MoU), save and except as agreed in writing between the Parties.
8. Each University shall keep confidential and not disclose to any person or institution or organisation any confidential information acquired by each University in connection with this MoU unless such information is already in the public domain, is required to be disclosed by law or any legal or regulatory authority, or the other University has previously received the prior written consent of the University for its disclosure.
9. This is the first generation of this MoU. This MoU is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent and becomes effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing.
