Clause No.13:

Special conditions for admission to Honours Course as follows:

Serial no. (i) to (xiv) remain unchanged and serial no. (xv) be included and be read as:

(xv) Human Rights: Candidates passed the previous qualifying examinations (10+2) in Humanities/Arts/Science/Home Science (Except Commerce).

The Generic Elective Courses that can be offered to the candidates taking up B.A. (Honours) in Human Rights, are as follows: Candidates cannot opt for any other subject except the subjects mentioned below:

- (a) **From Humanities division:** History, English, Bengali, Political Science, Philosophy, Sociology, Journalism & Mass Communication.
- (b) **From Science division:** Anthropology, Statistics, Environmental Science, Geography, Psychology, Computer Science, Economics.
- (c) **From Home Science division:** Human Development, Food & Nutrition.

Candidates have to choose at least one Generic Elective subject from the Humanities division.
